
This book spreads the good news of Catholic Social Teaching (CST) by commenting on its major documents and providing meditations on specific issues. *Catholic Social Teaching* is divided into four chapters. The first chapter deals with CST as an organic developing tradition with a prehistory of influential movements and a post-history of diverse responses to the official teachings. The second chapter includes commentaries on the seven themes of CST as identified by the U.S. bishops. The next chapter analyses and comments on the major pastoral letters of the U.S. bishops. The final chapter has a

series of meditations on important justice and peace issues including abortion and care for creation; with personal examples and questions to guide reflection.



FR. JAMES BACIK is a priest of the Diocese of Toledo and is the former pastor of Corpus Christi University Parish in Toledo. He has a doctorate in theology from the University of Oxford and has published numerous articles and more than fifteen books. Fr. Bacik has taught graduate theology courses at the University of Notre Dame, Fordham University, the University of San Francisco, and the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. He has also lectured widely in the United States and internationally.

The Image of the Invisible God


The canticle from the Letter to Colossians is a kind of kalei-The canticle from the Letter to Colossians is a kind of kalei-doscopic progression of revelation, presenting powerful images of the mystery of Christ's resurrection as it moves from verse to verse. Each verse—sometimes each individual line—expands our perception of the scope of God's great work of salvation through Jesus Christ. Christ is the beloved Son who ushers us from dark-ness to light, be is the Redeemer who has purchased forgiveness for us by his death on the cross. Christ is the firstborn of the new creation, in which we become his brothers and sisters. He makes visible for us the invisible Cod, whom we now behold in Christ sense in this earthly acritence. Christ bods woo have the form; even in this earthly existence. Christ's body now has its form in the Church, and as the head of this body, he has primacy over all created things; he is revealed now to everyone and everything as their origin and source. He has accomplished for this world, brotheir origin and source. He has accomplished for this world, broken and burdened by sin, the reconciliation that reunites earth and heaven. Each of these progressive images builds up for the believing Christian a sense of the immeasurable impact of the power of God, unleashed in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Our response of thanksgiving, limited as it is to merely human terms, can never reflect the full extent of God's plan for our deliverance as realized in Christ; yet the very words in which these images are couched make it possible for us to articulate our own belief in God's grand design for the salvation of the world.



Yet the way of life that follows upon our recognition and acceptance of the good news of Christ's resurrection also necessarily places moral expectations on us, matters of justice and righteousness. During this period, he begins to discover his differentness through various sexual and spiritual awakenings, while growing into his vocation to the Catholic priesthood.

The "OUT" section shows him awakening to his gay sexual orientation. During this period, beginning with his ordination to the priesthood, he realizes its major conflict: his vows, especially celibate chastity, compete with his sexual drive for human relationships. He struggles with the question of is it one or the other, or is there a way he can be both?


The "WITH" section, corre-
